The School Board may accept a major construction, additions or remodeling project @betificate of Occupancy has been granted by the building department of the local iggvlexordy. A Certificate of Substantial Completion which records the date of substantial completion of the work by the contractor or substantial completion of a designated portion; thereof shall be issued by the project architect in conjunction with a "Punch list" to the Director of Facilities.

RULE 7500 ACCEPTANCE OF COMPLETED PROJECT

The architect/engineer shall prepare a complete list of all items related to the construction of the building and site which have not been completed in accordance with the plans, specifications and building codes. A copy of the inspection list shall be sent to the Director of Facilities Services.

All warranties, guarantees, operating manuals or spare parts, as required by the specifications, shall be submitted to the Director of Facilities Services prior to acceptance pfoliect. The above shall be included in the inspection list if such items have not been previously submitted.
